This one-hour program will focus on how to enforce contracts of all kinds. Suzanne and Joe will discuss issues that commonly arise in breach of contract and related claims. The program will cover issues concerning contract formation, including the enforceability of letters of intent, term sheets, oral agreements, implied agreements, and performance in the face of unsigned drafts. They will also discuss remedies, including damages theories and specific performance, as well as related non-contract claims and theories of recovery. The program will address strategies for litigating breach of contract claims, including whether to seek injunctive or declaratory relief, and whether to consider alternative dispute resolution such as arbitration or mediation.
